The Ship's Store has added a couple of new items to it's inventory that we felt would be of interest to most.

Working along with **Vito Calamita BT3 80-83, Ship Store Operator**, and **Rich Greene, Association President** we came up with a lapel/hat pin and a new coffee mug. The lapel/hat pin will sell for \$2.50 each plus shipping.

As you can see it's the DDG 17 logo.



It's made of Cloisonne material, It is 1 inch in size, measuring diagonally, 1.2mm thickness and has a 8.0mm post and butterfly clutch. I personally think it is a great addition to our ship's store, something to add to your hat or the lapel of your suit jacket.

We have not had a coffee mug in

the inventory for several years. We now have one. It is an 11oz white coated ceramic mug, again with the ship logo digitally applied on the mug. As you can see in the picture if drinking right handed the logo will be facing away from you.



The mug will sell for \$4.50 each plus shipping.
